STUDENT DRESS CODE POLICY

Preamble

Allegra School Coffs Harbour does not require students to wear a uniform, however the School has an expectation of all students to maintain a neat and tidy appearance at all times.

Scope

This policy relates to the students to ensure they understand and adhere to our dress code requirements.

Policy

A student dress code was developed to meet occupational health and safety standards and community expectations. Students are required to follow reasonable staff directions based on, but not limited to the restrictions listed in this policy. Continued breaches of the dress code will result in disciplinary action.

Students are restricted from wearing includes:

- Revealing shorts, skirts or tops
- Boob tubes or crop tops (midriffs are not to be exposed)
- Clothing that promotes offensive/ illegal or immoral behaviour
- Clothing with drug and/or alcohol slogans or imagery
- Any garment that is designed for or could be considered sleep wear
- Sheer or see through clothing
- Clothing that reveals or exposes undergarments.

Students must meet the following requirements:

- Students must wear covered shoes at all times
- We encourage Students to wear sun smart clothing when participating in outdoor activities. This may include wearing sun protective hats, shirts that cover the shoulders, upper arms and neck, and longer shorts and skirts that cover the upper thighs
- Personal protective clothing and equipment is provided for Science classes and must be worn when instructed by the Teacher
- When attending excursions and field trips, Students are to dress accordingly and meet the specific requirements for attending the trips.
